In line with the Presidential Proclamation No. 922 “*Declaring A State Of Public Health Emergency Throughout The Philippines*” and the Memorandum from the Executive Secretary regarding the “*Stringent Social Distancing Measures and Further Guidelines for the Management of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Situation*,” the Tourism Promotions Board (TPB) shall enforce the following **Interim Measures in its Operation and the Delivery of its Service to all its stakeholders starting 16 March 2020**:
